Homework routines:

- The children will be set Times Table targets at regular intervals with dates for testing in school
- Occasional homework tasks will be set (usually of a more creative nature) linked to the topics as appropriate
- Please encourage your child to read daily. Practising reading aloud is very helpful for improving expression. We ask that Y4 children will be heard read at home by an adult x3 weekly and Y5 x2 weekly. Reading records will be checked on Fridays. Please ensure children have their reading book and reading record in school every day. Children of this age still enjoy listening to their parents read a book to them!
